New this year will be “hands on” workshops in addition to our regular educational seminar opportunities. We have limited space, so secure your spot by booking and paying for your workshops, seminars and speakers early.

1. **INCREASED AUDIENCE:** With in-person exhibitor workshops and access to the seminars, we expect high participation at the event. In 2022 our show welcomed over 700 delegates, 40 exhibitors and 200 exhibitor staff which was amazing as COVID protocols were still in place. Again, this year, we will be advertising and promoting our event coast-to-coast, from British Columbia to Newfoundland, and expect to have delegates attending from across the country.
2. **BROADER REACH:** Our focus continues to be the commercial dental laboratory space but as technology in both the lab and dental office is growing in importance, we are expanding our reach to include digital dental technology and its application/integrated workflows in the dental office as well as in the lab. We had several dentists and representatives from dental offices in attendance in 2022 and expect that this trend will continue as dental offices explore digital technology products for their offices.

3. **NEW WORKSHOP ROOMS:** New for 2023, we have three rooms for exhibitors to hold small hands-on educational workshops, live demonstrations and in-room learning away from the noise and bustle of the main exhibit hall. There are only three workshop rooms available and preferential booking privileges will be offered to major sponsors and returning exhibitors who have a large footprint on the trade show floor. Other returning and new exhibitors may book workshop spaces on a first-come first-served basis.

4. **NATIONAL EVENT MARKETING:** We will be aggressively marketing to all provinces and territories - targeting denturists, dental technicians and dentists through virtual and print publications, e-blasts and direct advertising with the assistance of provincial and national associations of denturists, dental technicians, and dentists.

Application and Eligibility:

Application for booth space, seminars, workshop rooms and sponsorship opportunities must be made online via the DIAC website (www.diac.ca), must contain the information requested and be executed by an individual who has authority to contractually bind, pay, and act on behalf of the exhibitor. This exhibition is designed for in-person booth display and demonstration of products and services relating to the commercial dental lab practice, digital technology in dentistry, and the professional and commercial education of those individuals attending.

Each exhibitor/seminar sponsor/show sponsor acknowledges and agrees that DIAC will not be responsible for any damages, losses, costs, expenses, or contractual liabilities incurred by the exhibitor prior to receipt of the final notice of acceptance of the seminar and exhibit space.

DIAC will determine the eligibility of any company, product, or service (as per our Inclusion Policy on our website: www.diac.ca). DIAC may elect to decline the application of any company whose display of goods or services is not compatible, in the sole opinion of DIAC, with the educational character and objectives of the exhibition.

Businesses participating in and products being sold at the show **must** comply with all Health Canada requirements including the requirements to have a valid Medical Device Establishment Licence and valid Medical Device Licencing for Class II-IV products for sale in Canada as applicable. Exhibitors must adhere to their licence obligations. Unlicensed Class II, III and IV medical devices are prohibited from being displayed and/or sold at Technorama.

In the event an application is not accepted, any paid exhibitor/seminar/sponsorship fees will be returned within 30 days of the cancellation of the application.

To be eligible for DiAC member pricing your company must be a member in good standing with the Association, which means all outstanding 2022-2023 membership fees and/or prior charges must have been paid in full prior to December 31, 2022.

HST is applicable to all purchases. Prices listed in the Prospectus do not include HST.

Exhibitor Booths:

The Delta Plaza Ballroom ABC will be the main exhibit floor space.

Booth size is 10 ft x 10 ft.

Aisles between booths will be 12 feet wide to allow for easy flow of delegates without crowding. There will be a total of 67 booth spaces available in the main exhibit hall.

Booth locations will be assigned based according to the priority schedule and dates provided on page 11 of this Prospectus.

Booth price includes drape, one 6-foot table and two chairs. For additional booth needs, please review the Wright Display Exhibitors Kit to order additional materials or services.

Electrical hookups are not included in booth space and should be ordered directly through Wright Display, our show manager. A pricing sheet for Electrical services will be available in the Technorama 2023 Exhibitors Kit.

Public Health

We will be respecting all public health mandates and protocols imposed by federal, provincial, or municipal governments at the time of the show in March 2023 and will be monitoring and advising exhibitors if any additional requirements are necessary throughout the next few months. Please monitor the DIAC website for any announcements around public health protocols.

Food & Drink

No food or drinks can be consumed on the trade show floor or in the booths. An area will be set up in the foyer with tables and chairs for the consumption of food and drink.

Any edible “giveaways” like cookies etc. must be individually wrapped.

NEW for 2023!!! Workshop Rooms

Technorama 2023 is all about education, communication, networking and showcasing your new and existing product. New for this year, we have added three workshop rooms suitable for small groups of 8-15 persons (dependent on equipment needs) for hands-on learning, to perform live demonstrations, engage in demonstration learning and connect directly with delegates.

The Hamilton, Windsor and Ottawa rooms will be booked by the day and will be for sole exclusive use of the exhibitor to set up product and run concurrent educational, ‘hands-on’ training modules. Electrical hookups and additional power needs are to be arranged through Wright Displays at an additional cost.

Workshops must not be held during the Keynote Address scheduled on Friday March 31, 2023 between 12:45 and 1:45 pm.

Please be aware that workshop room exhibitors will be required to have a booth on the main exhibit floor.

Seminars 2023

As in past years, exhibitors can sponsor seminars/speakers. There will be 21 seminar slots over the two-day period. You must have a booth at the conference to be eligible to sponsor a seminar. Speakers need to be registered through the registration process on the DiAC website in advance of attending to ensure they have a badge produced for them. (Speaker badges are free).

Seminars will run concurrently in the Toronto A, Toronto B. and Montreal.

Here's what you need to do for your workshops and seminars:

Workshops – 3 Rooms

- Workshop rooms will be sold on a first-come-first-served basis. Payment must be received when purchasing a workshop room.
- Exhibitors will be required to provide a description of workshops and seminars and the names of the workshop/seminar leaders for the website and program books,
- Exhibitors are responsible for bringing the equipment into the hotel, setup, education, CE credits and certificate issuance, as well as take down and will work with the show managers, Wright Display on the logistics of the room set up,
- Additional Electrical needs will need to be arranged through Wright Displays/Encore and are **not included** in the room rental charge.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for ensuring room occupancy does not exceed maximum at any time and will control flow of participants.
- Advance sign up for the hands-on workshops will be through DiAC's event planning system on the website and a waiting list prepared for ease of use
- There will be a nominal cost to the delegates to reserve a workshop space and ensure attendance

Seminars – 3 rooms

- Seminar sponsors are responsible for submitting the title of their event, the name, picture, and bio of the speaker a general description of the content of the seminar.
- Sponsors will work with DiAC to ensure that the technology and content works. Audio Visual support will be provided for each of the three seminar rooms.

We need workshop and seminar details as soon as booked/possible to promote and sell the show. The deadline for submission of workshop and seminar details is Feb 22, 2023, for inclusion in the print program and event management on the website

Seminar sponsors are responsible for ensuring that all participants of their seminar receive a certificate for CE credits for their respective colleges.

Space for delegates in seminars will be first-come-first-served. Seminar sponsors should register participants with a sign-up sheet at the door so that you have the information to send the CE certificates.

Seminars will not be held during the Keynote Address scheduled on Friday March 31, 2023 between 12:45 and 1:45 pm.

No exhibitor entertainment may be scheduled to conflict with the DIAC official workshop, seminar program hours, keynote speaker, activity hours or exhibit hours.

Payment Procedures

All exhibitors must go online to the DiAC website Store to place orders for 2023 products. Credit card payment is preferred for all transactions. For U.S. exhibitors, please ensure your credit cards are able to transact in Canada.

Members of DiAC may request that they be invoiced for their purchases, except for the workshop rooms which are in high demand. Please advise of your payment preference.

Terms are net 30 days from date of purchase.

Workshop rooms must be paid at time of purchase.

Non-member exhibitors will be required to pay at the time of on-line order/registration. Fees are payable by credit card in Canadian funds through the DIAC online store on the website at www.diac.ca

Applications for Technorama exhibitor product will not be processed nor exhibitor booth space assigned until DiAC has received a completed application form and **payment in full**.

All payments must be received by January 31, 2023, or applications will be cancelled and those on the waiting list will be offered the workshop rooms and premium booth space.

Assignment of Booth Space

New for 2023! Exhibitors may rank their top three choices for booth allocation at the time of online application. The numbered exhibitor floor plan is posted on the website for reference.

Priority for booth location assignments will be as follows

- 1) Principal Sponsors of Technorama 2023
- 2) Exhibitors with two (2) or more booth spaces
- 3) Returning exhibitors
- 4) New exhibitors & non-profit exhibitors

Booth space will *not* be assigned until payment is received in full. The floor plan will begin to be filled in based on the above priority sequence on December 1, 2022. After February 1, 2023, booth locations will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis.

An application without payment will not be processed until payment is received.

Exhibitor Personnel Registration

Two exhibitor (2) badges per 10 x 10 booth space are included in the cost of each exhibitor booth. Representatives must be pre-registered on the DiAC website before February 28, 2023 and badges will be issued. Personnel registration begins online December 2, 2022.

All exhibitor employees and support staff who need access to the show floor during the hours it is open to delegates must be pre-registered and wear admittance badges. Security staff will be present to ensure every attendee is wearing a badge.

Additional exhibitor employees in excess of two per 10 x 10 booth can be registered on the DIAC website in advance of the conference. Additional staff above the 2 per booth will be registered at a cost of \$50.00 per person.

Speakers/presenters of sponsored seminars and workshops must be registered by the exhibitor presenting the seminar in order to receive badges. There is no cost associated with the issuance of a badge to a speaker/presenter at a sponsored seminar.

Exhibitor and speaker/presenter badges will be available for pick up at the registration desk starting at 8:30 am on Friday March 31, 2023 and Saturday April 1, 2023.

Reserved Block of Hotel Rooms

DiAC has secured a block of rooms for our exhibitors and their employees for a reduced rate of \$154.00 per room plus taxes. Rooms are available Thursday March 30th and Friday March 31st. Please ensure your representatives advise the hotel you are with Technorama 2023 when booking. Rooms are available on a first-come-first-served basis

To ensure you have a room, all rooms must be booked before March 8 to get the preferred rate. After March 8 the rooms are released from the block.

We had several exhibitors advise they could not get rooms in the hotel last year. Don't be disappointed - book early to reserve your rooms.

Code of Conduct and Professional Ethics

The Dental Industry Association of Canada is committed to maintaining an environment that encourages respect for the dignity of everyone. Discrimination, violence and/or harassment in any form, whether verbal, physical or environmental, which is directed toward a person's sex, gender and gender identity, race, age, marital status, disability, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, same-sex partnership status, or any other classification protected by law is prohibited. DiAC considers violation of this policy a serious offence that will lead to penalties which may include loss of privileges to exhibit at future DiAC events.

All exhibitors are required to conduct themselves in full compliance with all federal, provincial, and municipal laws and in full compliance of the Canadian Health Protection Branch, Workplace Hazardous Materials Information Systems and manufacturers' regulations, specifications and warranties related to the sale and distribution of health/dental care products at Technorama. Exhibitors selling expired, damaged, distressed, incomplete or repackaged products regulated by Health Canada's Health Products and Food Branch, Therapeutic Products Directorate, or Medical Devices Bureau may lose their right to exhibit at future Technorama shows.

Exhibitors must not exhibit and/or display such products or services that would constitute the promotion of a product known to be hazardous to health.

All Exhibitors are expected to operate in a fair, respectful manner towards fellow exhibitors and the Dental Industry Association. Interference with, sabotage of, disparagement, or slanderous comments or literature is strictly prohibited.

Terms of Show Attendance

All exhibits submitted for display at Technorama 2023 are subject to review.

To be eligible for DIAC Membership discounts, a company must be a member in good standing with DIAC and have paid all required membership fees by December 31, 2022 and show fees by February 28, 2023. Non-Member companies are required to pay fees at time of purchase/registration.

DIAC is under no obligation to extend application privileges to any company regardless of whether said company has exhibited previously.

All products and services exhibited must be germane to, effective and useful in the commercial lab practice or dental technology products.

Health Canada:

In Canada, certain medical devices; Class II, III and IV products fall under Health Canada Licencing requirements. Exhibitors must be able to provide, on request, proof of their Health Canada Medical Device licences as required and if selling medical devices of all classes, proof of their Medical Device Establishment Licence. Un-licenced Class II, III and IV products are prohibited from being sold at the show. All exhibitors should have a medical device establishment licence as required.

An exhibitor may display products that are in the process of being licenced in Canada or that do not require licencing. Product display or sales that may infringe on the registered trademark, copyright, or patent of another company are prohibited. Exhibitors may not display outside their booth space. Encroachment into aisles will not be allowed for health and safety reasons.

Exhibitors are entitled to only 2 company representatives per booth space:

Registration for 2 booth representatives is included in the cost of an exhibitor booth. Additional representatives should be paid for and registered in advance of the show to avoid registration delays. Walk-ins will be required to register and pay at the door. Manufacturers' representatives will not be allowed on the show floor unless they are pre-registered at their own booth or as one of the distributors' representatives. Badges are required for all persons who wish to gain entry onto the show floor and attend seminars.

Exhibitors must keep their exhibit open and properly staffed during the specified hours and shall not close or remove exhibit collateral until the conclusion of the conference.

Exhibits must not be deceptive or misleading, and as a rule, distributors should be authorized by the manufacturers to sell and distribute their products. Exhibits should be at a reasonable height and not create a visual barrier to other exhibitors.

Books and electronic media related to the commercial lab practice or dental technology products or of interest to denturists, dental technicians and dentists and their families are eligible for exhibition.

Distribution of materials or samples: Only bona fide exhibitors may distribute advertising materials at the show and only at the exhibitor booths.

Promotions that simulate editorial content must be clearly identified as advertising. The word 'advertising' must be prominently displayed.

The advertisement/display of goods or services other than those manufactured, distributed, or sold by the exhibitor in the regular course of business and identified in the exhibitor contract is prohibited.

An exhibitor may not assign, sublet, or apportion all or any part of the contract booth, nor may an exhibitor permit the display, promotion, sales or marketing of non-exhibitor products and services. Interviews, demonstration, and distribution of literature or samples must be made within the booth area assigned to the exhibitor.

Canvassing or distribution of advertising outside the exhibitor's own booth space will not be permitted unless the exhibitor has paid to be a sponsor and has DIAC's permission to do so.

Exhibitors are allowed to sell items only if sales transactions are conducted within the exhibitor's own booth.

Exhibitors may not conduct research or surveys or publish any information gathered at the Technorama 2023 conference without prior written consent from DIAC.

Activities Outside of Booth Space: Exhibitors may only engage with attendees in the exhibit hall or the three workshop rooms. Exhibitors may promote their products by sponsoring and hosting a seminar.

Sales by Non-Exhibiting Companies: Solicitation by non-exhibitors is prohibited. Companies and company representatives who have not purchased exhibit space are prohibited from attending or soliciting business at the conference. Distributors who have manufacturer representatives at their booth must ensure they are registered under your booth name and have been paid for as additional company representatives.

Exhibitor-Sponsored Contests will not be allowed in the exhibitor booths.

Cancellation

DIAC reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel any exhibit application or agreement at any time if the applicant has violated, or DIAC reasonably believes that the applicant will violate any of these exhibit rules and regulations or has engaged in or is engaging in any activity that reflects negatively on DIAC's image, goodwill, reputation or acceptance by its members or the public.

DIAC will not be liable for special, consequential, or incidental damages, loss or expense, directly or indirectly arising from, or in connection with, the cancellation of this exhibit notwithstanding notice to DIAC of the possibility of such damages, loss or expense. DIAC's maximum liability will not exceed the rental payment made to DIAC by the exhibitor.

Refund Policy

All cancellations must be submitted in writing.

Cancellation requests not submitted in writing will not be considered.
Full refunds will only be issued if notice is received by January 6, 2023.

A 50% penalty of the cost of the total booth space, seminar, workshop, sponsorship and/or advertising contracted will be imposed with a written cancellation received between January 6 and February 3rd, 2023.

No refunds will be given for cancellation requests received on or after Feb 3, 2023.

Force Majeure

Neither party shall be held responsible for delays or non-performance caused by activities or factors beyond its reasonable control, including without limitation, war, weather, pandemics, strikes, lockouts, fires, acts of God, terrorism cancellation of the event or any other activities or factors beyond its control that makes it inadvisable, impractical or impossible to hold the event, whether similar or dissimilar to any of the foregoing. If the event is cancelled through no malfeasance of the exhibitor, the exhibitor shall be entitled to a refund of any fees paid less expenses paid within a reasonable time period defined by DiAC.

Privacy

The information collected from exhibitors will be used by DiAC for the purpose of processing payments for booth space, workshops, seminars and sponsorships and for no other purpose. DiAC is committed to holding member and guest personal information private. Please refer to DiAC's privacy policy on our website: www.diac.ca

Indemnification & Insurance

By purchasing an exhibitor space, seminar or sponsorship, exhibitors agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Dental Industry Association of Canada, and each of their affiliates and subsidiaries, and each of their directors, members, officers, contractors, agents, employees, and representatives (each an “Indemnified Party”), from all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, actions, judgments, penalties, costs and expenses (including solicitor fees and costs) arising in, at, out of or in connection with the Exhibitor’s virtual exhibit or the design, maintenance, conduct, use, or operation of such exhibit or any part thereof, by Exhibitor of its officers, directors, employees, agents, contractors, representatives, invitees, agents or contractors. Such indemnification shall be effective regardless of any claim of negligence on the part of any Indemnified Party. This provision shall be construed to be incorporated into the Application.

Each party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other, its agents, and employees from and against all claims, liabilities, and expenses, including reasonable attorneys’ fees, arising from acts, omissions, or breach of this Agreement by the party or its agents or employees. The parties shall each maintain appropriate and sufficient insurance to cover their obligations under this Agreement.
